

Facts About Using Ethanol in Your Car

E10

- All unleaded fuel at the pump is blended with 10% Ethanol, making it a cleaner burning fuel.

E15

- E15 (or 15% ethanol) blend is available at a few stations, but only vehicles newer than 2001 should use it.
- Retailers can sell E15 as a registered fuel. Drivers will start seeing more stations offering E15 in the near future.
- Drivers need to look for this label on the pumps.



E85

- Flex-fuel vehicles are designed to run on fuels of any blend of ethanol up to 85% -- hence the name "flexible fuel" vehicle,
- Look for these badges on the back of vehicles to see if they are a Flex Fuel Vehicle! Or look for the yellow gas cap.
